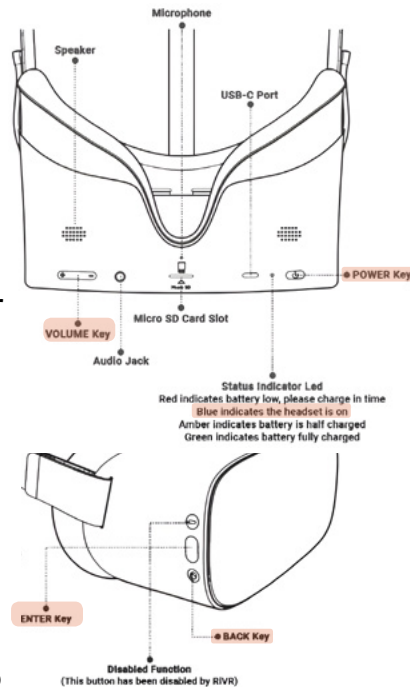


VR KIT USE WITHOUT LAPTOP

- Turn on headset – this is on the bottom on the right side.
- Volume is on the bottom, left side. You will find headphones under the headsets in the VR kit. The headphone jack is next to the volume button on the headsets. If people are seated close together they will be able to hear the video from the other headset unless the headphones are used.
- The “Enter” button is a pill shaped button on the right side of the headset.
- Below that is a smaller round button. That is used to center the headset and will move you back to the previous screen. The top button doesn’t do anything.



When you start your instructions please make sure everyone is seated. Some people feel a little dizzy at first, just have them touch the table and that will let their brain know they are just sitting at a table and they are fine.

Turn on the headset – button on the bottom. A blue light will appear.

If you wear glasses you can wear them with the headset. Look forward and you should see a feature wall. If it’s not straight ahead, look forward and press the small round button on the side of the headset. The screen should now be centered.

You will then look down and you will see a menu bar. You can also see the percentage the headset is charged in the menu bar.

On the menu bar, look at App. There will be a blue circle hovering over it. Press the pill shaped button. You may have to hold it a second before it will go to the next screen. On the next screen you will see instructions to double tap enter to view videos. Press the enter (pill shaped) button twice. You will now see 2 videos. Choose which video you want to view. The room with flashover first, or the room with the sprinkler first. To choose the video you want to see, look at it and a blue circle with hover over it. Press the pill shaped button to start the video.

Please remind people to look up, down and around. We forget that the video is 360.

When the video is finished you can press the small button to get back to the feature screen or just turn the headset off. Check that the blue light goes off. They can be a little temperamental if you don’t press it for just the right amount of time.

When you transport the case, the handle can be lowered or raised by pushing the small lever found about an inch from the edge on the bottom of the case.

For cleaning the headset, wipe the outside surface with alcohol or disinfectant wipes. Do not use these on the glass lens. You can **use a soft eyeglass cloth to remove smudges.**
